I will be grateful, if you could, like previous years, kindly issue instructions to your Education/Sports Department to hold the qualifying tournaments at the District and State level and sponsor the Champion School team from the State to participate in the (a) Girls, (b) Sub-Junior (Boys) and (c) the Junior (Boys) Tournaments.


I am sure that the State Government, as in the past, will kindly bear the travel expenses and also partly pay for board/lodging and local transport of the teams during their stay in Delhi. The Society will, of course, arrange suitable accommodation for the teams and will make appropriate boarding arrangements and ensure that wholesome food is served to them. **The subsidised charges for providing board/lodging and local transport will be Rs. 250/- per head per day.**

It is also mentioned that at the Junior level this is the only competition available in India and it needs to be strengthened in greater measure. Further it also enhances integration of children from all parts of India when they assemble under one roof and take part in healthy competition.
